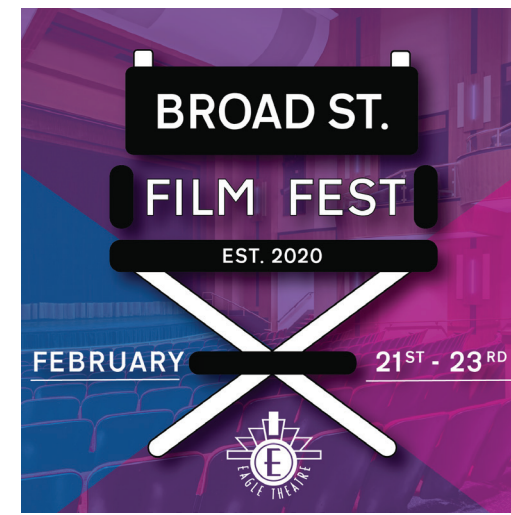

Sugar Hill's Historic Preservation Society celebrated the unveiling of the newest community historical marker on October 5th. The marker recognizes Sugar Hill's former city hall on West Broad Street, which now serves as the Suite Spot business incubator.



Veterans Day

Join friends, neighbors, and veterans at 10:30 am on Monday, November 11th as we honor those who served and dedicate Sugar Hill's new Veterans Memorial Plaza.

The Veterans Day program is presented in partnership with American Legion Post 127, The Suwanee Creek Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and Sugar Hill Historic Preservation Society. Recently, the Sugar Hill Business Alliance presented a \$5,000 donation of funds raised from their annual golf tournament held at the Sugar Hill Golf Club. Music will be provided by the Broad Street Concert Band followed by a flag raising ceremony, unveiling of the new veterans memorial, and wreath laying ceremony. Local restaurant, Rushing Trading Company will be offering coffee and pastries for veterans after the ceremony. Located across from Sugar Hill City Hall at the intersection of W. Broad Street and Church Street, the new Veterans Memorial Plaza features monuments recognizing each branch of military service as well as a water feature, and eternal flame surrounded by a community plaza with space for visitors to stop and reflect on the sacrifice and service of veterans and active military.
